



What are MADs



Protrude the mandible and open the airway



- \rightarrow 90 degree dorsal design.
- → 3D printed nylon.
- \rightarrow Small and strong.
- \rightarrow Simple titration.
- → Perfect fit.

How they work

High Compliance - 82% (Vanderveekan et al, 2013)

- Average use of 7.5 hours per night (Ngiam, 2015)
- Patients Prefer Oral Appliances to CPAP (Phillips et al, 2013)
- Similar Health Outcomes to CPAP (Phillips et al, 2013)
- Portable
- Discreet & Simple to use
- Potential side effects TMJ and Tooth Tenderness, occlusal changes may occur

Phillips et al 2013

Similar Health Outcomes in patients with Moderate to Severe OSA after treatment with CPAP and Oral Appliances. The similarity of CPAP to MAS was most likely due to efficacy of CPAP being offset by the inferior compliance compared to oral appliances.

Anandam et al 2013

506 Patients observed over a 6.5 year period found treatment with Oral Devices may be equivalent to CPAP in reducing CV mortality in severe patients with OSA when observed over a 6.5 year period.

Charite et.al 2015

Both CPAP and MAS significantly eliminated breathing cessations and reduced BP, positive HRV were observed with MAS.

Benefits of a Mandibular Advancement Splint (MAS)

Consult structure

 Talk patient through oral appliance therapy using the Hushd Pro Avera information sheet

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
• If patient is ok to proceed talk through costs of therapy (This will be the clinics fees as per below and the dentists consult fees – capped at \$2000).

Explain steps

- Dental monitoring scan
- Hushd Avera prescription (start therapy today) Optional
- Good Sleep Test monitoring show therapy is working today optional
- Refer to workflow sheet to show patient dental process

Note: To discuss with patient the consult fees in the clinic it's important to walk them through how valuable having the dental monitoring scan is along with efficacy testing of the Avera, the patient can also keep the Good Sleep Test and use for ongoing monitoring once they have their custom made device. Costs of dental providers for this service is usually \$3000-\$4000 depending on the dentist. 3 year cost of therapy is still less than or on par with CPAP.



Performing the consult

- 1. Refer to dental monitoring guide for how to complete dental monitoring scan
- 2. Export dental monitoring report and attach to lab case Creating a Lab Case see resource in consult guide
- 3. Hushd Avera prescription Refer to how to use guide for prescribing the Hushd Avera
- 4. Good Sleep Test Set up 5 day test in Resdent for patient or ongoing patient monitoring
- 5. Give patient practice information for dental clinic in which they have been referred
- 6. Give patient information pack
