BookBook is designed to hold your ID, a small number of debit/credit cards and a few bills or receipts inside the pocket. Have extra cards? Try using Apple Pay for your bank cards, and the Wallet app to store your movie tickets, loyalty cards and more.

Turn BookBook into a Display Stand.

On first use, sharply fold the back cover outwards along the middle crease. Lift and rest the left edge of iPhone on the front cover. The crease will soften and become more pliable with use.



Never miss a picture.

Be sure to align the camera lens with the cut-out when placing the iPhone Case into BookBook Folio.

Charging Wirelessly?

Simply remove the iPhone + Case from the BookBook Folio and place on your wireless charger to power up.
