
- WARNING: Do not use this product without reading the instructions first.
- **WARNING:** The cot should no longer be used when the child can sit up, kneel up or stand up unaided.
- **WARNING:** Placing additional elements in the cot may cause asphyxiation.
- **WARNING:** Do not place the product near any other products that could cause a danger of asphyxiation or strangulation, for example: strings, curtains, cords, etc.
- The assembly elements must always be securely fastened and inspected. This is to ensure they do not collapse and to prevent any of the elements from coming loose. This is important to avoid your child or your child's clothing being trapped and causing strangulation.
- The crib should always be placed on a horizontal floor.
- Gaps should not be filled with pillows, blankets or other items.
- DO NOT let children play near the crib without supervision.
- When the child is unsupervised in the crib, make sure that the rail
 is always up, correctly fastened in place and that the zips are fully
 closed.
- DO NOT use the product if any of the parts are broken, damaged or missing. Contact Baby Elegance for replacement parts and extra instructions if necessary. DO NOT replace any of the parts yourself.
- DO NOT use accessories that have not be approved by the manufacturer.
- Make sure that all of the assembly devices are correctly fitted, as well as the locking devices.
- Never use the cover without the metal structure.
- WARNING: To avoid the risk of your child's neck being caught on the
 - top rail next to the adult bed, please ensure this rail is not higher than the adult bed mattress.

- WARNING: To avoid the risk of strangulation, the attachment system to the adult bed should always be kept out of the crib and out of reach.
- **WARNING:** Do not use more than one mattress in the crib.
- **WARNING:** To prevent the risk of fire: avoid placing the crib close to a fire or other sources of heat, such as electric or gas heating devices, etc.
- To avoid the risk of falls and suffocation, never put two or more mattresses in the cot.
- WARNING: Only use the mattress sold with this crib, do not add a second mattress on this one, suffocation hazards
- **DANGER!** Always raise the drop side completely when the crib is not attached to the adult bed.
- **DO NOT** use the crib with following types of adults beds:
 - The adult bed height is less than 49cm from floor to top of adult mattress
 - The adult bed width is more than 180cm.
- **WARNING:** This bedside sleeper is suitable for a bed with an independent bed edge component, which can be attached with the anchor strap from the bedside sleeper.
- **WARNING:** Never add a sleep aid to the crib that is higher than the red line printed on the lining of the crib.
- **WARNING**: Both sides of the crib should be set at the same height when in use.






assembly instructions




1. Take the frame out of the box carefully.

The bedside sleeper should be placed on a level floor.



2. Push down each of the legs until it locks.




3. Lift the upper frame until it locks.













5. Fasten the velcro under the bassinet body to the frame.



6. Push the wheels into the legs to lock them.




7. Fit the mattress into the bassinet.





Adjusting the bassinet height


- To raise or lower, press the height adjuster button on the side of the bassinet.
- 2) Repeat to the other side. There are 6 different height positions.



Locking and unlocking the wheels

1) Push down the clip to lock the wheels. Lift the clip to release the wheels.

Always apply the brake when the child is in the bassinet.



Using as free standing bassinet


- 1) Lift the mesh panel and click together to connect both ends of the top rail.
- 2) Close the zipper on both sides.
- 3) Store the anchor strap under the bassinet.









fixing to adult bed for bedside sleeper mode



1. Open the zippers on the mesh panel.



2. Push the button under the side panel bar upwards. At the same time, pull it out to disengage the mesh panel.




3. Drop the mesh panel down.












4. Move the sleeper close to the parent's bed. Check the height of the sleeper against the height of the bed. The height of the open side edge (after the mesh panel has been lowered) should always be aligned with the height of the parent's mattress.



5. To fix the sleeper securely to parent's bed, pull the anchor straps from under the bedside sleeper and slide under and over the bed base.



6. Lock the buckles under the bedside sleeper and tighten the straps until the sleeper is firmly attached.




7. Push down to lock the wheels before using the bedside sleeper.










folding the sleeper / bassinet








1. Take the mattress out of the sleeper / bassinet. Unfasten the side cover and peel off to fold the arms down.




2. Push the button under the side moulding downwards and at the same time lift the top rail. Repeat on the other side. Top rails will fold down.








3. To fold, push the sides of the bassinet base together.



4. Wrap the mattress around the sleeper and fasten with the velcro attached to the underside of the mattress.



5. Push the button inside the lower part of the legs upwards to fold in the sleeper/bassinet feet.





safety information

WARNINGS

- **NEVER** leave baby in the bassinet with the side down unless it is positioned in bedside sleeper mode and attached securely to the parent's bed.
- The bedside sleeper is only suitable to use with adult beds that are between 43 and 53 centimetres in height from floor to top of the adult mattress.
- The bedside sleeper is suitable for an infant up to approximately 6 months of age. Please discontinue use when your child is able to sit, kneel or pull itself up.


FALL HAZARD


- When using as a free standing bassinet, never leave baby without the top horizontal rail installed in the upper most position.
- Please discontinue use when your child is able to sit, kneel or pull itself up
 or has reached the maximum weight of 9 kilograms, whichever comes first.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your doctor.
- To avoid the infant's neck being caught on the top rail next to the bed, the rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.
- ALWAYS raise the side of the sleeper when not fastened to the adult bed.

ENTRAPMENT HAZARD

- To prevent death from entrapment, the bedside sleeper must be properly secured to adult bed using the attachment system.
- There must be no more than a 1/2 inch (13mm) gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed
- Check tightness before each use by pulling bedside sleeper away from adult bed.
- If gap exceeds 1/2 inch (13mm), **DO NOT** use product. **DO NOT** fill the gap with pillows, blankets or other items that are suffocation hazards.








NEVER use the bedside sleeper in the co-sleeping position without the anchor strap attached around the adult bed base and buckled under the bedside sleeper.

Ensure the anchor strap is securely buckled and tightly pulled.

WARNING:

There must be no more than 2cm gap between bedside sleeper and adult bed.










care and maintenance

- To prolong the life of your bedside sleeper keep it clean and do not leave it in direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
- Removable fabric covers and trims may be cleaned using warm water with a household soap or mild detergent. Allow it to dry fully, preferably away from direct sunlight.
- Non removable fabric covers and trims may be spot cleaned using a damp sponge with soap or mild detergent. Allow it to dry completely before folding or storing away.
- DO NOT dry clean or use bleach.

- DO NOT machine wash, tumble or spin dry, unless indicated on care labeling.
- In some climates the covers and trims may be affected by mould and mildew.
 To help prevent this occurring, do not fold or store the product if damp or wet.
 Always store the product in a well ventilated area.
- Regularly inspect and maintain your product to ensure all components are working correctly. To maintain the safety of your nursery product, seek prompt repair of bent, torn, worn or broken parts.









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
