Replacement Guide V2 Trolley Handle



After many journeys, your suitcase may experience some small malfunctions. We have designed our products so that repairs are simple to manage, ensuring sustainability.

Step 1:

Open your suitcase and lay it flat.

Step 2:

Unzip the lining to expose the inner trolley system. If there is protective foam inside, gently remove it.

Step 3:

Locate the screws securing the trolley:

Four screws near the top, underneath the handle.

Two screws at the base of the poles (you may need to remove a thin layer of foam to access these).

Step 4:

Unscrew all six screws, keeping track of which ones go where, as different screws may be used in different areas.

Step 5:

Once the screws are removed, pull the metal trolley poles out of the plastic brace at the bottom and slide the trolley out by the exterior handle.

Step 6:

Insert the new trolley system, ensuring the metal poles pass through the inner reinforcement.

Step 7:

Fit the base of the poles into the plastic brace at the bottom of the suitcase.

Step 8:

Align all screw holes and secure the trolley in place by fastening all six screws. Ensure each screw is fully tightened.

Step 9:

Zip the lining back up, and you're all set!

Test the trolley system by extending and retracting the handle, ensuring smooth movement.
