

Removing the Adapter:

New-FD Bayonet Mount

Press the lens release on your lens and turn to remove adapter

FD/FL Breech-Mount

Turn the ring on the lens until adapter is removed

Mounting the Adapter:

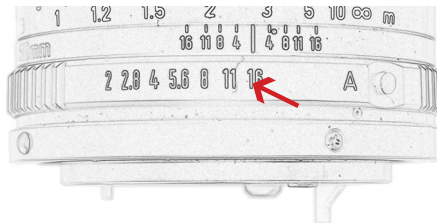
- 1 Before mounting the adapter on any FD-Mount type, (Regular Lock mount or Breech-Lock Mount) you must place the adapter ring on Install



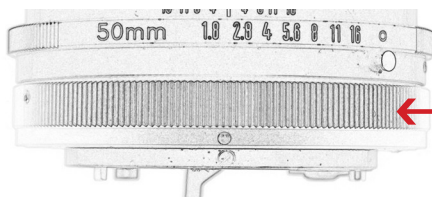
New-FD Bayonet Mount

- 2 Set your lens to any aperture except for auto (bayonet mount only)

Bayonet mounts are identified by a red dot next to the lens release button →



FD/FL Breech-Mount

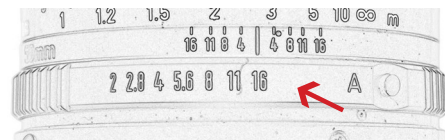


Breech-Lock Mounts are identified by this black or silver ring

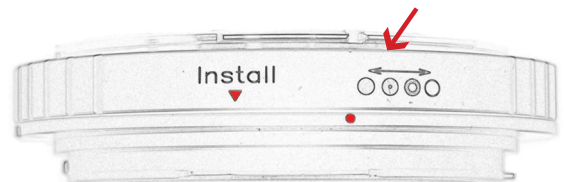
- 3 Match the lens and adapter markings and turn adapter for bayonet mount. Turn ring on lens for breech mount until securely locked

Operating the Adapter:

If you'd like to operate the lens aperture with the adapter; on your lens, set the aperture to the smallest opening and use the adapter ring



If you'd like to operate the lens aperture with the lens; place the adapter ring on the small aperture icon and control the aperture on the lens



Macro Photography:

Unscrew the glass holder and remove glass for macro photography.

Store Glass in a safe place to avoid scratches
