

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Main shade (9' x 7')
- Shade tension poles (2)
- Upright support poles (2)
- Strut pole (1)
- Stakes (4)*
- Guylines/Tensioners (4)*
- Suction cup anchors (2)*
- Suction cup anchors with velcro strap for attaching to strut pole (2)*
- Tall-Connect cords for easy overhead anchoring (4)
- Carrying bag with shoulder strap


ASSEMBLY SHADE KEY Tension Poles Grommets Guylines Support Poles Strut Pole*

*Strut pole only used when structure is narrower than shade



STEP 1

DETERMINE MOUNTING



Mount on a van, car, trailer, tree, fence; You name it.

STEP 2

ATTACH ANCHORS



It's very important that your anchor points are secure! If using suction cups, be sure to wipe the surface clean first and make sure they're securely attached before proceeding.

STEP 3 *strut pole may not be needed

ASSEMBLE & ATTACH STRUT POLE



Use strut pole if mounting MoonShade to anchor points less than 7 feet apart.

STEP 4 CONNECT SHADE TO ANCHORS



If strut pole is used, securely attach it directly to anchors. Suction cups with velcro straps can be used with the strut pole to attach MoonShade to smaller vehicles.

STEP 5

ASSEMBLE & ATTACH POLES



Assemble tension and support poles. Place tension poles in corner pockets diagonally across MoonShade and attach clips.

STEP 6

SET UP SUPPORT POLES




Place support poles in front corner grommets and hoist shade into an upright position. Visit moonfab.com/setup to see how to run support poles diagonally to the side of your vehicle by attaching suction cups to the base of the poles.

STEP 7

SECURE & TENSION GUYLINES



Attach guylines to loops in front corners of



Using the included stakes or other secure ground anchors, attach guylines and use the included line tensioners to secure your MoonShade in place
