
Warranty and Returns:

Tools needed: 5/32" Allen/hex wrench 7/16" (or adjustable) wrench

Assembly:

Determine which set of mounting holes on the platform to attach the Front Wheel Holder to. Remove the existing fork mount and riser block if necessary.

Place the 1-1/2" button head screws through the holes in the Front Wheel Holder and place it onto the platform so that the Front Wheel Holder's forks are angled towards the pumps on your rack's SeaSucker vacuum mounts. Push the screws through the holes in the platform and out through the bottom. Place a washer and a nut onto each screw. Tighten securely with wrenches.

Mounting Your Quick-Release Front Wheel:

Place your front wheel's quick-release skewer into the Front Wheel Holder's slots as if you were mounting your wheel to your bike's fork. Let the wheel drop all the way down into the slots until the tire is resting on the bottom of the Front Wheel Holder. Tighten your quick-release skewer normally and securely.

Mounting Your Thru-Axle Front Wheel:

This product is only compatible with 100mm wide through-axle wheels. You will need a set of 12mm Road Plugs or 15mm MTB Plugs, depending on your wheel's hub size. These items are available online at www.seasucker.com.

Press the 12mm Road Plugs or 15mm MTB Plugs into each side of your wheel's hub. Remove the acorn nut and spring from the
