Instructions

Set Up:


Replace the skewer nut on your bike's rear wheel with the threaded skewer nut included with the Hogg. Tighten and tension the rear skewer securely as you would with a standard skewer nut.


Attaching the Front Wheel:


- 1.Screw the Hogg onto the threaded skewer nut and hand tighten. Note that the Hogg and skewer nut have reverse threads turn the Hogg counter-clockwise to attach and clockwise to remove. See Diagram 1.
- 2.Attach your front wheel to the Hogg by inserting the wheel's skewer nut into the Hogg cavity. Tighten the skewer as you would normally to secure the wheel to the Hogg. See Diagram 2.
- 3. Thread the Anti-Rotation Strap around and through both the front and rear wheels to stabilize your front wheel and to prevent it from spinning while driving. See Diagram 3.

Removing the Front Wheel:

- 1.Remove the Anti-Rotation Strap and store it in a safe place.
- 2.Unclamp your front wheel and remove it from the Hogg
- 3. Unscrew the Hogg from the rear skewer nut (clockwise) and store it in a safe place.
